Beginning of Term provisions:

SECTION 2-1.

(de) Election and Term—The terms of council <u>membersors</u> shall be 2 years beginning on the first secular day of January that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, after their election <u>continuing and</u> until their successors are qualified. <u>No person shall be eligible for election to</u> the city council for a seventh consecutive term.

SECTION 3-1. Mayor; Election; Term; Compensation

The mayor shall be the chief executive officer of the city. The mayor shall devote full time to the office and shall not hold any other elective public office, nor actively engage in any other business, occupation or profession during the term of office as mayor. The mayor shall hold office for the term of 4 years from the first business day of January following the election and until the mayor's successor is qualified.

SECTION 4-1. Composition; Eligibility; Election and Term

(c) Election and Term—The term of each school committee member shall be 2 years beginning on the first day of January after the member's election that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday and shall continue until a successor is qualified. No person shall be eligible for election to the school committee for a fifth consecutive full term.
