Traffic Council – New Regulations

Please be advised Traffic Council added some traffic changes at their April 16, 2020 meeting. These changes became official and legal on May 7, 2020

The changes are outlined below. Signs have been ordered and are in the process of being installed. Please monitor these locations and begin enforcement once you see the new signage in place.

NO TURN ON RED - A new No Turn on Red restriction has been added to the Parking and Traffic Regulations at Beacon Street, westbound onto Sumner Street.

NO TURN ON RED - A new No Turn on Red restriction has been added to the Parking and Traffic Regulations at Beacon Street, eastbound onto Langley Road.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING SPACE - A new accessible parking space has been added on Elm Street in front of Paddy's Public House restaurant.

STOP SIGNS REMOVED – Roosevelt Road, both directions at Theodore Road

At the January 23, 2020 Traffic Council meeting, Traffic Council voted to remove the stop signs in both directions on Roosevelt Road and keeping the stops signs on Theodore Road. The decision to remove the stop signs in both directions on Roosevelt Road at the intersection of Theodore Road was appealed to the Public Safety and Transportation Committee of the City Council. At May 13, 2020 meeting of the PS&T Committee, the appeal was denied. Thus, the stop signs in both directions on Roosevelt Road at the intersection of Theodore Road will be removed. DPW will be removing the signs shortly. The stop signs on Theodore Road at Roosevelt Road will remain.
