5. 50 Beacon Street – Certificate of Appropriateness

Request to repair or replace damaged exterior elements, to change the stair approach to the house, to build a matching bay by the entry door, and to build a breezeway/connector between the house and garage, an enclosed set of stairs against the garage, and a two-story rear addition.

6. 9 Old Orchard Road – Certificate of Appropriateness

Request to build rear addition, modify the covered walk on the left side, remove storm windows and replace windows, repair clapboard siding, remove existing skylights and add new skylights, change color palette, and change landscaping.
