4. 106 Old Orchard Road – Certificate of Appropriateness

Request to install copper chimney caps.

Request to replace all the existing windows and eight doors.

Request to replace roof with solar roof tiles.

5. 40 Acacia Avenue – Certificate of Appropriateness (Violation)

Request for approval of evergreens planted to screen the HVAC equipment on the left side of the house that is in violation. Continuation.

6. 9 Acacia Avenue – Certificate of Appropriateness

Request to remove ornamental bridge at the front of the property.
