#229-20 Special Permit to allow multi-family dwelling at 13-17 Gardner Street

ANDREW CONSIGLI/CIVICO GARDNER, LLC petition for SPECIAL PERMIT/SITE PLAN APPROVAL to combine two parcels, raze the existing single- and two-family dwellings and construct a fourunit multi-family dwelling, altering and extending the nonconforming front and side setbacks and to allow a retaining wall greater than four feet within a setback at 13-17 Gardner Street, Ward 1, Newton, on land known as Section 11 Block 25 Lots 5 and 6, containing approximately 16,579 sq. ft. of total land in a district zoned MULTI RESIDENCE 2.
