THURSDAY, JUNE 25, 2020

Remote Participation:

Present: David Koses, Traffic Council Chair; Captain Anastasia, Newton Police Department; Isaac Prizant, Traffic Engineer; Councilor Downs and Alicia Wilson, Resident Member

Mr. Prizant provided a PowerPoint presentation, attached to this report.

TC17-20 MATTHEW KALISKY, 239 Watertown Street, on behalf of Jesse Corey, 64 Oak

Cliff Road, requesting on the north side of Watertown Street in Nonantum between Adams Street and Bridge Street the removal of 2-3 metered parking spaces, closest to Adams Street, in order for MBTA buses 59 outbound and 558 inbound to pull over to board and alight passengers. Currently, the bus stop is

within the main travel lane. (Ward 1) [03/05/20 @ 2:50 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 641. TPR 641 approves

option 2, which removes two parking meters on the north side of Watertown Street, closest to Bridge Street, and relocates the MBTA bus stop location.

The existing bus shelter remains in its current location.

This item may be appealed through the close of business July 15, 2020.

NOTE: Council members were provided with a location map, site photos and two options for consideration.

Mr. Koses stated that it is necessary to create a safe, accessible bus stop zone. He then provided two options for consideration. Both options allow the bus shelter to remain at its current location.

Option 1

Remove three metered parking spaces. Two spaces would remain on the north side of the block. This option keeps the bus stop closest to the bus shelter. The bus can pull over safely.

Option 2

Remove two metered parking spaces. Three spaces would remain on the north side of the block. This option shifts the bus stop closer to Bridge Street. This option is preferred by the MBTA. The bus can pull flush with the curb (improved access for people with disabilities, strollers, etc. However, passengers waiting in bus shelter must walk a little further to board the bus. The bus can pull over safely.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present. A resident stated that it would be preferable if the driveway to Dunkin Donuts was closed to allow the bus to pull

over and parking would not be removed. A resident said that either option is acceptable because it allows the bus to pull over safely.

Captain Anastasia stated that Chief McDonald prefers option 2. Council members briefly discussed options 1 and 2 determining it would be best to approve option 2, only removes two metered parking spaces.

Without further discussion, Mr. Prizant made a motion to approve option 2, Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business July 15, 2020.

Mr. Koses stated that due to the location of the new driveway and curb cut into Garden Remedies parking lot he recommends creating a no parking zone on Court Street between the utility pole and Washington Street allowing east access into and out of the driveway without site line difficulties.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present. Residents expressed their concerns and questions.

Concerns:

A resident stated that drivers have the tendency to park near the corner and try to 'squeeze' in next to the utility pole and fire hydrant making it difficult to exit and enter the driveway. Drivers have the tendency to double park on Court Street to visit the liquor store, especially during the holidays.

Mr. Prizant stated that it is illegal to park within 10 feet of a fire hydrant. Mr. Koses stated that if drivers are parking between the fire hydrant and the proposed no parking sign the driver could be ticketed.

Questions:

A resident asked how they could propose 'do not idle' signs? He then said that this is a great lunch location for business people.

Mr. Koses answered that 'do not idle' signs are not approved through Traffic Council. Captain Anastasia answered that State Law prohibits 'do not idle' signs except in school locations. He then suggested the resident call the Police.

Captain Anastasia asked the resident the distance between the utility pole and fire hydrant. The resident answered approximately 15 feet, enough space for a small vehicle.

Without further discussion, Councilor Downs made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business July 15, 2020.
