Some polling locations moved this year to provide more space for physical distancing. I need to correct the information we provided in Thursday's Update to include the Ward 3 polling locations that also changed for Nov. 3:

- If you voted at Cabot Park Village (Ward 2, Precinct 2), you will now vote at the Cabot School at 229 Cabot Street (corner of Bridges Avenue).
- If you voted at the Newton Community Service Center (Ward 3, Precinct 1), you will now vote at the former Horace Mann School, 687 Watertown Street (corner of Watertown Street and Albemarle Road).
- If you voted at the Newton Community Service Center (Ward 3, Precinct 3), you will vote at the Franklin School, 125 Derby Street.
- If you voted at the Waban Library Center (Ward 5, Precincts 3 and 4), you will now vote at the Zervas School, 30 Beethoven Avenue (corner of Beacon Street).
- If you voted at the Weeks House (Ward 6, Precinct 2), you will now vote at the Bowen School, 280 Cypress Street.

NewMo users can ride to the polls for free on election day.

You can drop your mail-in ballots in the boxes at City Hall until 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday.
