Nadia Good afternoon. I hope you are well. Can you please forward the following to Planning regarding the Riverside Project? Thank you. Alicia

As part of the Land Use process for the Riverside project, I would like to know what can be done to establish a neighborhood friendly speed on Grove (25 mph). The speed limit on Grove is currently 30 mph in front of the Riverside site and north. This regulatory speed limit is not safe or comfortable for non-drivers with the current roadway configuration, especially north of the site. I have heard from several residents of the area that speed along here is a concern and one they would like addressed. Given the likely increase in pedestrian and bicycle traffic near the site as well as the close proximity of the homes and Williams Elementary School located directly on Grove, I believe this would be beneficial to the neighborhood and help support more walking and biking.
