**SUBJECT:** 140 Windermere Road - Certificate of Appropriateness

At a scheduled meeting and public hearing on February 20, 2018 the Auburndale Historic District Commission, by vote of 5-0,

RESOLVED to issue a Certificate of Appropriateness for the project as presented at <a href="140">140</a> Windermere Road with the following required changes: 1) the chimney will be full-depth brick and will not be veneer; 2) the second-floor dormers will be narrowed so that they are subordinate to the first-floor windows; and 3) the right-side library will have three-foot-high railings. A set of the revised drawings must be submitted to Staff for review and final approval. The scope of the project includes demolishing the existing rear addition, left side porch and garage; building up and renovating the existing house; and building a new rear addition, left side porch with pergola and attached garage.
