As requested, Vanasse & Associates, Inc. (VAI) has provided a Trip Generation Comparison for the potential redevelopment of the Atrium Mall in Newton, Massachusetts. The Atrium Mall is currently vacant, but previously accommodated approximately 260,500 sf of retail spaces. The potential redevelopment could accommodate the following mixed uses.

As shown, the potential use could be a mix of retail, offices, restaurants and laboratory space. Based upon industry trip generation standards, a comparison of the prior retail use to the mixed-use was completed. The trip generation comparison is shown in Table 1.



As shown in Table 1, the change from all retail to a mixed-use is expected to generate less traffic during the weekday and weekends on a daily basis and less traffic during the weekday evening and Saturday midday peak hours. Only during the weekday morning peak hour would there be an expected traffic increase.
