2--There is very limited on street parking (metered). Very small parking lot for the employees of the building.

3--The traffic going into Whole Foods and Marty's on any given day can cause a traffic jam.

4--Our Lady's Church and CATS academy are located down the street (not sure if more then 500ft.)

5--The traffic from the new housing to be constructed on Court St. would empty onto Washington St. at the end of the block where Garden Remedies would be located.
