Exhibit 2 – Description of Activities (Pursuant to Section 30-36(e)(1))

The site presently contains a two-story, 4,480 square foot building occupied by three other tenants: a massage business, an acupuncturist and an optician. The applicant proposes to open a Registered Marijuana Dispensary in one of the first floor suites, with storage space in the basement.

The applicant will be dispensing medical marijuana, medical marijuana infused products and vaporizers to patients at the site. The medical marijuana products will be cultivated, processed and packaged at the applicant's cultivation facility in another municipality. The medical marijuana products will be delivered to the Newton site in childproof containers which are sealed and labeled per the DPH's regulations. No processing of the products will take place onsite. The hours of operation will be as noted in Exhibit 1, Section 30-36(d)(8).

Patients must have a DPH registration card and an appointment at Garden Remedies to gain admission to the site. As shown on the floor plan, there will be a secure reception area where a receptionist will check patients' credentials before buzzing them into the dispensary. The DPH also allows caregivers to accompany patients into dispensaries, but such caregivers would be required to obtain their own DPH identification card.

During an appointment, patients will receive individualized counseling from employees about the benefits of medical marijuana, and will be educated about the different types of products and strains available. They will also have the opportunity to avail themselves of printed literature and watch videos while they are in the dispensary. Information, including videos will also be available on Garden Remedies' website. Once they have selected the product appropriate to their needs, patients will purchase their product. Patients will receive the product in a sealed container, which they may neither open nor consume on-site. The site has been designed to accommodate up to five patients at a time. However, it is anticipated that two or three patients will be at the site at any one time.

Once a patient has had an initial appointment at Garden Remedies, he or she may elect to have future purchases delivered directly to their homes. These deliveries will typically originate from the cultivation site.
