New 48-seat locally owned restaurant providing moderately priced bistro fare served in a friendly, inviting atmosphere. David Punch, who is the owner and chef of Ten Tables restaurant at the Cambridge location, is seeking to open a similar restaurant in Newton Centre. Ten Tables restaurant has been recognized by major magazines such as Bon Appétit, Gourmet, Boston Magazine, Yankee Magazine.

The proposed location is 753A-755 Beacon Street, Newton Centre, which is a commercial use building in a BU-1 zoning district.
