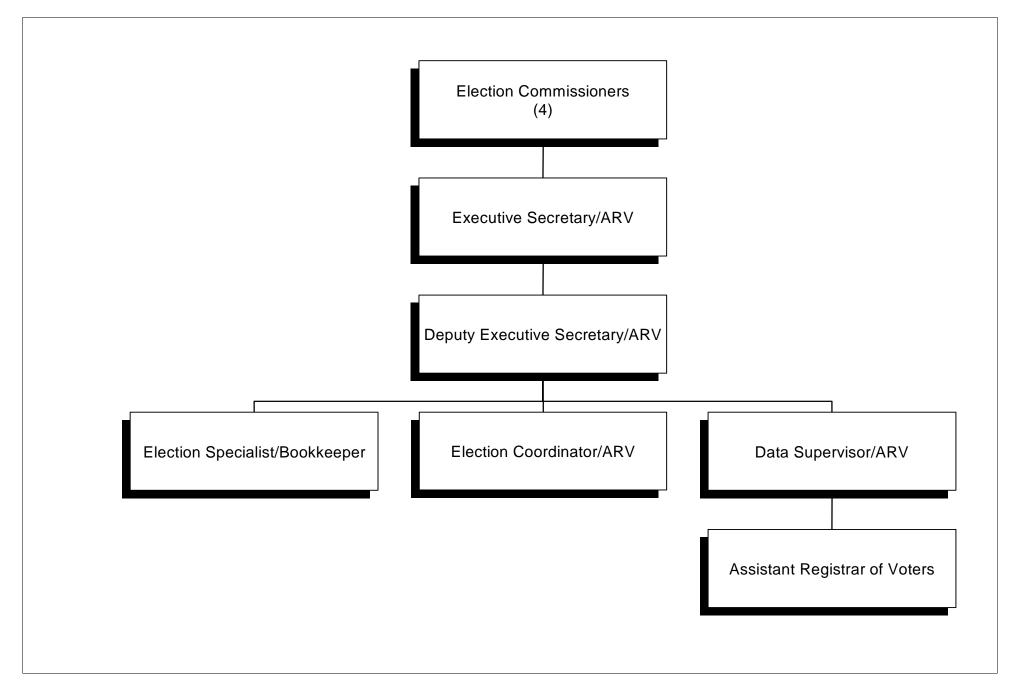

### **ELECTIONS COMMISSION**

### DEPARTMENT DESCRIPTION

The Newton Election Commission is responsible for conducting all Federal, State, and Municipal Elections in accordance with Massachusetts Election Laws and Regulations as well as the City of Newton Charter.

The Commission also manages the City's Annual Census, in an effort to make a true list containing as nearly ascertainable, the name, date of birth, occupation, nationality (if not a U.S. citizen) and residence of every person three years of age or older.

Additionally the Commission is responsible for the oversight and inspection of Municipal Campaign and Political Finance Reports for accuracy and compliance with State Campaign Finance Laws.

The Commission performs the following functions:

- Administers the City's Federal, State and Municipal Elections.
- Provides oversight and inspection of Municipal Campaign and Political Finance Reports for accuracy and compliance with State Campaign Finance Laws.

- Certifies nomination papers for Federal, State and Municipal offices and petition papers for ballot questions.
- Conduct the City's Annual Census.
- Oversees voter registrations and the updating of the Voter Registry Information System, which includes all newly registered voters, political party enrollment changes, name changes, address changes and the purging of voters.
- Provides census and voter data to the public on request.

### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

- <u>Elections</u>: Successfully conducted 3 elections which included a Preliminary, Municipal and Presidential Primary. A Special Election will be held on Tuesday, May 20, 2008.
- <u>Certification of Signature</u>: The Commission is required to certify nomination papers for all candidates who will seek federal and state district offices. It is estimated to exceed 6,000 signatures by year's end.
- <u>City Annual Census</u>: The Commission is currently processing the census and anticipating its completion by June at which time the Annual Residents List will be available.
- <u>Modems</u>: Increased the capacity of modem transfer from 27 to 29 of the 31 voting precincts.

- <u>Financial Audits</u>: Performed campaign financial audits for all candidates who ran for office in the Preliminary and Municipal Elections. Conducted year end financial audits for all individuals who have political committees. The Commission will also be required to audit any ballot question committees that organize for the upcoming Special Election.
- <u>Training</u>: Trained all wardens and clerks on election procedures and the use of the new AutoMark machines.
- Reduced Workforce: The Commission experienced an unanticipated loss of one of its employees and maintained it's efficiencies in day to day operations as well as preparations for all elections.
- <u>High School Students</u>: The Commission with the assistance of the League of Women Voters was able to have students from both high schools participate as poll workers in the Municipal Election and Presidential Primary.
- Accessibility: The Commission with the assistance of the Mayor's Committee for People with Disabilities is in the process of installing an automatic door opener at the Hyde Community Center to assist physically challenged voters to better access Ward 5, Pct. 2 and Ward 6, Pct, 3 polling sites.

#### GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

• Administer the following elections:

- o State Primary, Tuesday, September 16, 2008
- o State Election, Tuesday, November 4, 2008
- Certify all candidates' nomination papers for the offices of Mayor, Alderman-At-Large, Ward Alderman and School Committee Members.
- Review Municipal Candidate Finance Reports
- Maintain statistics on voter registrations, change of enrollments, change of addresses and purge voters for two elections.
- Train all wardens and clerks on any changes in election law and to review Election Day procedures.
- Increase high school student's participation during Election Day as poll workers.
- Process the 2009 City Census
- Publish the 2009 Annual Street List Directory
- Finalize modem transfers for all precincts for election results.
