<u>HER HONOR THE MAYOR</u> requesting a change to the Police Chief Selection Committee. The following individual, Alison Tarmy be appointed to the Police Chief Selection Committee in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 5 of Chapter

279 of the Acts of 1992 and Sec. 3-3 of the City Charter.

This docket item requests the appointment withdrawal of Hattie Kerwin Derrick who will start as the new Director of Community Engagement and Inclusion in the Executive office on January 11, 2021. Mayor Fuller requests the appointment of Alison Tarmy to serve on the Police Chief Selection Committee for her term to begin once City Council approves this request.

It was stated that Ms. Tarmy's experience on the Newton Police Task Force Committee will assist the City in their goal of finding a new Police Chief.

Chair Downs stated that the City Councils goal in passing a Vision Zero Resolution was to use crash, fatalities and injury data to determine where it is necessary to make infrastructure changes. It is hopeful, the next Police Chief will work and partner with the City Council.
