#20-21 Request to extend the appointment of Newton Retired Police Chief Howard L.

<u>HER HONOR THE MAYOR</u> in accordance with Section 3-6 of the City of Newton Charter, requesting authorization to extend the appointment of Newton Police Department Retired Police Chief Howard L. Mintz as Interim Chief of Police until

such time as a permanent Chief of Police has been named and is in place.
