The Fire Department respectfully requests permission to utilize funding remaining from the appropriation allotted for the purchase of Ladder Truck #2. After purchasing and outfitting with equipment there is a balance of \$139,254.11 remaining in account 7608E210-585030.

We would like to purchase with the remaining funds a used spare ladder truck. Our 2 spare trucks, Tower Ladder 5 (2007) and Ladder 4 (1995) are no longer in service due to mechanical issues which are too costly to repair and have safety issues. We have been borrowing ladder trucks (when available) from Boston Fire and Waltham Fire. This is not in the best interest of the Newton Fire Department when we are in need of repair or regular service.
