

Project Overview

- Existing wood picket fence running along the west/Jackson Road boundary of the property is badly deteriorated and in danger of collapse
- Fence has been repaired and reinforced over the years - replacement now only option
- Historic documentation shows picket style fence in this location since at least 1930s.

Funding Request

- ► Historic Newton is working with Steelco Fence to reconstruct the ca. 1940s wood picket fence using period appropriate details
- ► Proposal to install 210 feet of 4' high custom scallop-topped cedar picket fencing in the same location as the existing fence along the Jackson Road sidewalk with Post Saver sleeves on the end posts to protect them from deterioration
- ► The project has been reviewed and approved by the Newton Historical Commission
