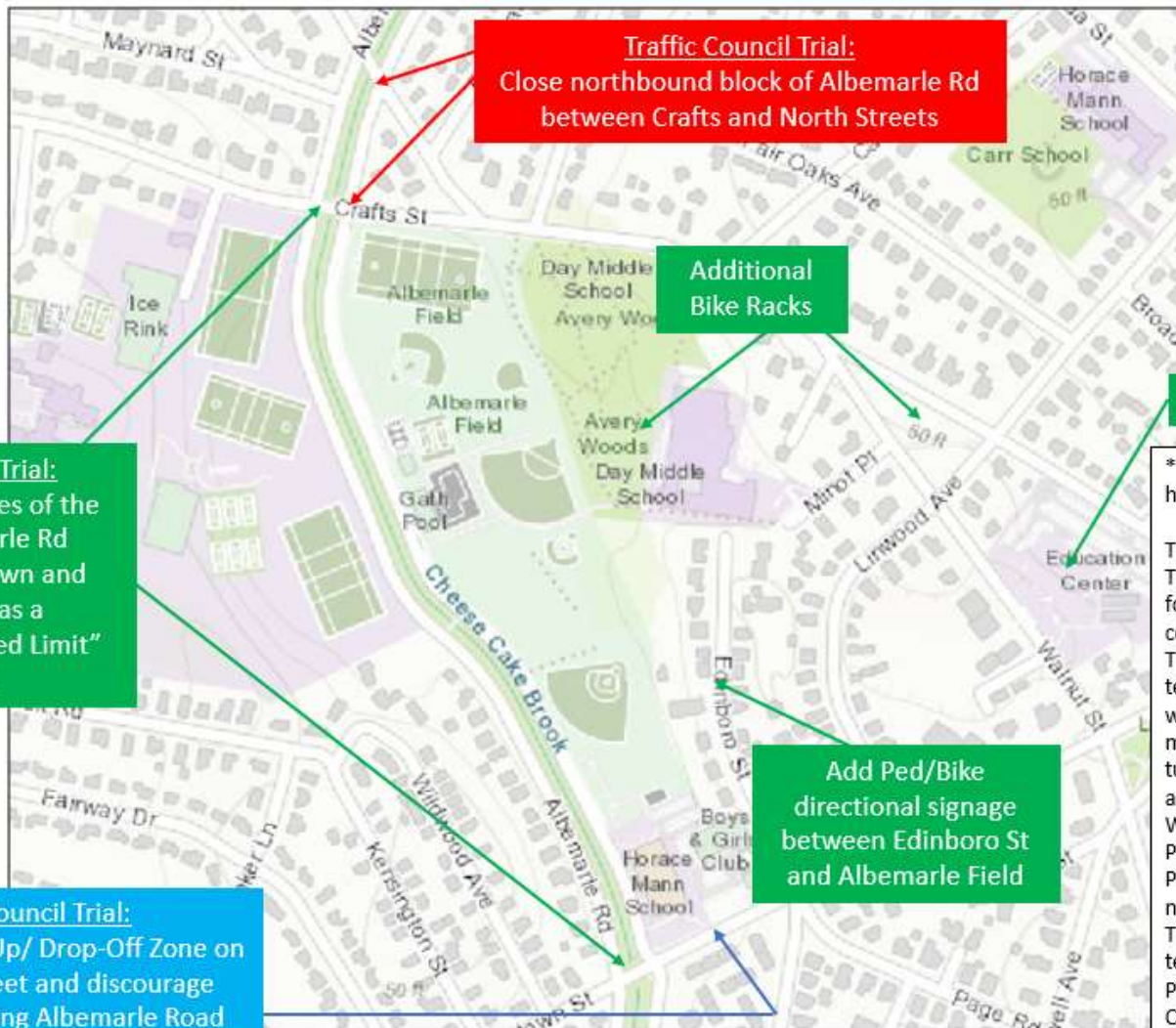


Day Middle School – Temporary Changes to the Traffic and Parking*



Traffic Council Trial:
 All signalized intersections within 1500 feet of Day will include "No Turn on Red" signs (all approaches)
 *Watertown at Albemarle
 *Watertown at Page/Edinboro
 *Watertown at Walnut
 *Watertown at Crafts
 *Crafts at Linwood
 *Crafts at North

Some staff can park in the Ed Center Lot

Traffic Council Trial:
 Designate both sides of the block of Albemarle Rd between Watertown and Crafts Streets as a "Safety Zone Speed Limit" (20 MPH).

Traffic Council Trial:
 Designate a Pick-Up/ Drop-Off Zone on Watertown Street and discourage parents from using Albemarle Road

* On 6/25/20, the Newton Traffic Council voted 5-0 to hold the following item for a trial:

TC115-20: JASON SOBEL, DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION OPERATIONS, requesting the following to respond to safety concerns and changing conditions brought on by the Covid-19 Pandemic: Traffic Council shall be allowed to vote to allow long-term trials on any public street or parking area located within 1,500 feet of a school. These temporary trials may include modifications to the traffic flow, parking, turning restrictions and/or pavement markings, and are to be approved by the Commissioner of Public Works in consultation with the Director of the Planning Department and the Chief of the Newton Police Department. These changes are temporary in nature and would revert to original conditions unless Traffic Council subsequently votes to make these temporary conditions permanent. At any time, the Police Department may end any Traffic Council trial. (Wards 1-8) [06/18/20 @ 9:19 AM]
