Appeal of TC 156-20 Statement of Reasons for Appeal

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This appeal of TC 156-20 is made by residents of Grasmere Street in opposition to the inclusion of Grasmere Street in the Newton Corner Parking District. The reasons for the appeal are as follows:

- 1. Ord. 19-202 does not allow the Traffic Council to establish a parking district unless certain factual preconditions specified in the ordinance are established. The Traffic Council has not established nor attempted to establish the existence of those preconditions in this case.
- 2. Consequently, TC 156-20 is outside the scope of Traffic Council's authority to create a parking district under Ord. 19-202.
- 3. TC 156-20 was decided at the request of one household on Grasmere Street who wishes to obtain a resident parking permit to park legally in front of their house. A desire of residents to park in front of their houses is not a legal justification for creating a parking district under Ord 19-202.
- 4. Establishing a parking district that includes the issuance of nonresident parking permits is not rationally related to the desire of residents to park in front of their houses.
- 5. Residents who wish to establish a resident parking program can petition the Traffic Council to create one under Ord. 19-201.
- 6. At the hearing at which TC 156-20 was adopted, four residents spoke in opposition to the inclusion of Grasmere Street in the district. Reasons cited for the objections were:
 - a. Allowing resident parking on both sides of the street is dangerous for children who play in the street given the traffic on the street to access the park at the end as well as other parts of the neighborhood.
 - b. Parking on both sides of the dead end section of Grasmere Street is dangerous in that it would limit access of emergency vehicles to the houses at the end of the street.
 - c. Including Grasmere Street but none of the other streets in the neighborhood is arbitrary and makes the parking regulations in the neighborhood inconsistent.
 - d. There is no existing parking problem (i.e., no "inequity in parking impacts") which including Grasmere Street in the district would address.
 - e. If Grasmere Street is included in the district, the impacts of nonresident parking would be concentrated at the southern end of the street, close to Washington Street.
 - f. There are private alternatives for residents who desire more parking, such as increasing driveway size or reducing vehicle ownership.
 - g. Residents like the current parking restrictions, which tend to limit the number of cars parked on the street and generally improve the aesthetic of the neighborhood.
- 7. Traffic Council ignored the comments from residents who were opposed to the inclusion of Grasmere Street in the parking district.

8. The existing parking restrictions were established at the initiative of residents in order to address an issue with nonresident parking in the neighborhood.

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9. Residents of Grasmere Street would like to control the parking restrictions on the street by the ordinary process under Ord. 19-28.

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•Appeals for intersectional controls/regulations (traffic signals, stop signs, no turn on red, etc.) require a total of <u>six (6) signatures (including appellant's)</u> from owners or tenants whose building or lot of land is located within five-hundred (500) feet of the affected intersection <u>(one signature per household or business)</u>.

•Appeals for parking restrictions, truck exclusions, speed limits, and all other traffic regulations must be signed by one (1) owner or tenant of <u>at least half</u> of the residential, commercial and/or non-profit units which abut the affected street or way, provided that in <u>no event shall more than ten (10)</u> <u>signatures (including appellant's)</u> be required (one signature per household or business).

To the Committee:

The purpose of this letter is to appeal TC 156-20 relating to the expansion of the Newton Corner parking district and to demand nullification of same.¹ This matter was brought before the Traffic Council (hereinafter "TC") by City Councilors on behalf of three households within the district and was subject to a public hearing on November 12, 2020. TC voted unanimously to expand the district over numerous objections. As described below, TC 156-20 is beyond the legal authority of TC and must be invalided.

TC purports to derive its authority for TC 156-20 from Ord. 19-202. That ordinance provides that TC may "establish" a parking district only if the specific criteria set forth in the ordinance are satisfied: There must exist "an area comprised of contiguous streets where demand for on-street parking necessitates a comprehensive approach to managing parking". And the rules of the parking district must serve the purpose of "creating consistent parking regulations and equitably distributing parking impacts throughout the district." TC does not have legal authority under Ord. 19-202 to create a parking district to address any other problem or serve any other purpose. Ord. 19-202 does not give TC authority to "expand" a parking district; only to "establish" one.

It should be noted that TC does not have the authority to establish a parking district upon petition by residents or a City Councilor pursuant to Ord. 19-28 without establishing the existence of the requisite factual preconditions under Ord. 19-202. Ord. 19-28 relates to "parking restrictions" affecting a "street or way"; it contains no provisions relating to establishment of a parking district.

In the instant case, TC acted at the request of a few petitioning households from some of the affected streets who wish to park legally on the street notwithstanding the existing 2-hour parking restrictions. TC 156-20 expands an existing parking district to encompass a greater area and implements a system of resident parking stickers which would exempt permit-holders from the 2-hour parking restrictions. TC 156-20 also authorizes the issuance of nonresident stickers for the district, with a different number of nonresident stickers per street.

¹Ord. 19-202 does not provide for an administrative appeal. Nonetheless, by copy of this letter to the Newton City Clerk's office, I hereby make an administrative appeal pursuant to Ord. 19-34 solely for the purpose of reserving legal rights.

Because TC has no authority to expand the geographic area of an existing parking district, TC 156-20 is on its face beyond the powers of TC pursuant to Ord. 19-202.

Further, TC has not justified the exercise of its authority under the criteria set forth in Ord. 19-202. The desire of residents to park in front of their houses is not the kind of "demand" to which Ord. 19-202 refers. That ordinance was intended to target specific areas with a high demand for nonresident parking where inconsistent regulations were creating disparate parking impacts in different parts of a neighborhood. There is a different ordinance to address the desire of residents to park in front of their houses: Ord. 19-201, which prescribes a mechanism for creating a resident sticker program upon the petition of interested residents and does not involve the issuance of nonresident permits. That mechanism has safeguards to ensure that the creation of the sticker program has broad support among affected residents.

TC also justified expansion of the district as a way to address an imagined or hoped demand for commuter parking. However, TC provided no evidence that a demand for such parking actually exists.² It did not articulate how parking regulations within the district are inconsistent nor how the district reduces those inconsistencies. It did not identify any existing inequity in parking impacts within the district nor describe how expanding the district reduces inequity. And it did not explain how expansion of a district qualifies as a "comprehensive approach" when it appears to be piecemeal, nor why no reasonable alternatives exist to address the alleged commuter demand. The only "evidence" presented were photographs of streets in the district which did not evidence the existence of inequitable parking impacts.

At the hearing, specific objections were raised by residents to the inclusion of Grasmere Street in the district that (1) the inclusion of Grasmere Street, which is a spur in the district, is arbitrary, and creates rather than reduces inconsistency; (2) if commuter demand existed, the expansion of the district would increase inequity by concentrating the effects of potential commuter parking on Grasmere Street in areas closest to Washington Street³; and (3) private remedies exist which are an alternative to creating the district, including reducing vehicle ownership or expanding driveways. This evidence was ignored. The response of Mr. Koses was that the residents of Grasmere Street will like it, they just don't know it yet. He stated that any inconsistencies would be remedied when the district was expanded further.

It was evident from TC's responses to these objections that TC had made its decision regarding TC 156-20 prior to the public hearing and that the hearing was perfunctory. It appears that sponsors of TC 156-20 and members of TC are in favor of opening up greater on-street parking in furtherance of policy objectives related to zoning, development and density that have nothing to do with the purpose and intent of Ord. 19-202. TC does not have the legal authority to pursue policy objectives and using the authority of TC in this manner is an abuse of TC's power.

² Furthermore, TC argued that greater flexibility for residents is necessary as a result of COVID restrictions. This claim is evidence that commuter demand does not currently exist.

³ The petitioner who resides on Grasmere Street lives at the northern end; it appears the southern block of Grasmere was included in order to make the northern block contiguous with the rest of the district to the south.

Mr. Koses provided a PowerPoint presentation, attached to this report.

- TC156-20 COUNCILORS LEARY, GREENBERG and DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR, on behalf of Nicholas O'Connor of 154 Washington Street and Meagan McGinnes of 241 Tremont Street, Newton Corner, requesting to expand the Newton Corner Parking District to include Tremont Street, Whittemore Road, Hibbard Road, the section of Waverley Avenue between Tremont Street and Washington Street, and the section of Washington Street between St. James Street and the Boston City Line. If approved, this item would change the parking regulations in these areas and would allow residents to purchase a resident permit, which would permit them to park their vehicles for a longer period than the posted time limit allows. - ACTION: APPROVED AS AMENDED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 697. TPR 697 extends the Newton Corner Parking District to the following locations, with a 2-hour limit 8am-6pm, except by Newton Corner permit: Grasmere Street, Tremont Street, the section of Washington Street between Hibbard Road and the Boston City Line, the section of Waverley Avenue between Tremont Street and Washington Street, and Whittemore Road. Hibbard Road and the section of Washington Street between St. James Street and Hibbard Road are not included in the Parking District and the current parking regulations in these areas are not changed. This item restricts parking on the southern side of Whittemore Road due to the narrow width of the street, for safety purposes.

This item may be appealed through the close of business December 2, 2020.

NOTE: Council members were provided with a location map, site photos, options for consideration, and a recommendation.

Mr. Koses introduced TC156-20 and TC162-20 together. Mr. Koses recommended No Action Necessary for TC162-20 since it could be added into TC156-20. Mr. Koses said that over the past month many residents have said the parking regulations in this neighborhood are not working, especially during the pandemic. He said that a primary reason for the current parking regulations was to satisfy requests from neighborhood residents to prevent too many commuters from parking in the area. This parking plan will create more uniform parking regulations in the neighborhood that will be easier to enforce. Residents will be able to purchase permits to park longer from the Traffic Bureau. This street-sharing approach will benefit residents by allowing them to park on their street throughout the day, if needed. Parking stickers cost \$25 per year per vehicle (up to two vehicles per household), plus each household can request up to two free visitor passes.

Mr. Koses explained some of the current restrictions already in place.

Mr. Koses also presented data on the current parking situation in the neighborhood, showing the estimated number of available parking spaces available on each street. Two different proposals were shown for Whittemore Road: one allowed parking on only one side while the other allowed parking on both sides.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present.

Residents present expressed their concerns, questions, and support.

Concerns:

- Residents said that the streets are incredibly narrow and too much on-street parking will harm visibility and maneuverability.
- On some of these streets, emergency vehicles and snowplows can have trouble getting through.
- Adding more on-street parking will harm the aesthetic character of the neighborhood.
- A resident said that due to the narrow streets, no non-residents should be given permits.
- Grasmere Street should not be included because its addition is arbitrary without the other streets close to it.

Support:

• Residents said many driveways in these neighborhoods are too narrow to accommodate their own vehicles plus those of service workers.

- A resident who supported the proposal said that each street is different and may need individual solutions.
- The current parking situation is difficult for emergency vehicles and trash collection.
- Some residents who supported the proposal said Hibbard Road should be removed due to its narrow width and the wishes of the residents there.
- Residents agreed with using resident permits and guest placards.

Questions:

- A resident asked why there could be two non-resident parking permits on Playstead Road while there were none on Whittemore Road and eight on Tremont Street. Mr. Koses answered that he measured the viable parking space on each street and for every 250 feet he planned for one non-resident permit. These permit allowances can be changed if needed.
- Residents asked about permit guidelines and restrictions. Mr. Koses answered that what is proposed is a two-hour limit from 8am-6pm except for Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays except by Newton Corner permit. He clarified that this would not override the winter parking ban or no parking during a declared snow emergency. Only houses that abut streets which are included within the Parking District would be able to purchase permits.
- A resident asked whether curbs could be painted to mark the five feet from driveways that cars are not allowed to park in on the street. Mr. Koses said that this is such a common violation that the Public Works Department could not paint curbs everywhere it is needed, but that the Traffic Bureau is very effective in enforcing this regulation.

Eric and Neelam Secemsky of 79 Grasmere Street spoke in favor of the proposal. They said that Grasmere Street should be added to the proposal because there is nowhere for nannies or other service workers to park for homes with smaller driveways. It would also be helpful to residents who have small driveways and who need to park on the street out of necessity.

Responding to multiple residents, Mr. Koses said that parking districts are developed to meet resident requests. Overall, residents have had positive reactions to being included within parking districts. On-street parking is one tool used for traffic calming. He also said that, per ordinance, all of the streets included in a neighborhood parking district need to be contiguous. Seeing no other comments, public comment was closed.

Councilor Greenberg asked if there was any feedback for the parking district program in place on Ricker Road. Mr. Koses answered that there has been no feedback from residents, positive or negative. She later said that she was in favor of adding Grasmere Street and that on-street parking was a better alternative to more driveway paving.

Councilor Leary said that parking is a resource that needs to be fairly allocated as street. This is a plan that would provide more legal parking options to residents and people should call the police for parking violations. More on-street parking will also prevent people from paving over their yards to create additional parking. She said that this type of neighborhood parking districts would provide benefits, but that if problems arise, the plan can always be revisited later. Captain Boudreau also said that these parking plans have usually been a success and that on some streets like Whittemore, parking on both sides makes them too narrow.

Mr. Fischman said that he felt the 7am-9am parking restriction for non-permitted cars was satisfactory for the parking district and that one-side parking was the best idea for Whittemore Road. He also asked about the two-hour limit on Tremont Street and Mr. Koses said that it worked for the area.

Councilor Markiewicz said that there has been good luck with parking programs. He asked about whether the extension into Grasmere Street was a good idea based on testimony. Mr. Koses said that it could be removed but that the majority of residents were either in favor or did not provide input. Councilor Markiewicz approved.

Mr. Freudberg said that he was skeptical about changing the parking conditions on Hibbard Road and the nearby section of Washington Street because resident testimony seemed to be content with the current situation. He suggested allowing parking on only one side of Grasmere Street


Mr. Prizant said that he would like to see Grasmere Street included, but the whole street would need to be included so the plan could be contiguous. Based on testimony Hibbard Road should be removed and given time to see if the residents wish to be included within the parking district. Whittemore Road should be one-sided parking only.

The consensus from Traffic Council was to remove Hibbard Road from the parking district proposal. Waverley Road still connects the parking district, making it viable.


Traffic Council agreed 5-0 to remove Hibbard Road and the section of Washington Street extending between Hibbard Road and St. James Street from the parking district.



I am writing with concerns and questions about the permit parking allowed on Grasmere St.

1) Several homes on the southernmost end ofGrasmere are multi-family with renters. Can each rental unit apply for 2 permits plus 2 passes?

Yes every unit that abuts Grasmere Street is eligible.

2) Has anyone done the math to determine exactly how many cars might be parked on this small residential street at any given time?

Appx 62 cars can fit on the street if every single space is parked up at the same time.

3) What is to stop people from leasing their parking passes to Brighton residents just over the border or commuters?

4) Are residents of surrounding streets in Hunnewell Hill allowed to obtain permits to park on Grasmere? Or is it simply residents of Grasmere?

Residents of Grasmere + potentially a small number of non-residents of the street.

5) I'm not convinced the permits are a good idea; however, given the city thinks they are, why would the City continue to allow parking on both sides of the street? This is a residential enclave with already narrow streets. Many children walking to school and playing. It's unsafe to have congested parking on both sides. Why would the City not change the parking rules to account for the likely increase in street parking?

Primarily to benefit the residents of the street themselves, and their visitors, so that they do not get ticketed for parking longer than 2 hours, and to avoid the inconvenience to some Grasmere Street residents who now need to move their car around to avoid being ticketed.

This program was created primarily to give residents the option of parking on their own street for longer than 2 hours, if they want.

M E M O R A N D U M

On December 3, 2007, the Board of Aldermen approved as amended, docket item #421-05, which authorized changes to the structure of the Traffic Council. At that time, the Committee requested an annual update of Traffic Council Actions. The attached information is provided to the Committee as requested. *No action is necessary*.

During 2020, Traffic Council held eleven evening meetings and two daytime meetings. As shown in Appendix A, during 2020 Traffic Council heard 181 items and took final action on all but three of them. Many of the items heard in 2020 were edits to the Traffic and Parking Regulations, which made no change to conditions in the field. A list of all items heard during 2020 is shown in Appendix B, including the following three items, which are still being held:

 TC115-20 JASON SOBEL, DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION OPERATIONS, requesting the following to respond to safety concerns and changing conditions brought on by the Covid-19 Pandemic: Traffic Council shall be allowed to vote to allow long-term trials on any public street or parking area located within 1,500 feet of a school. These temporary trials may include modifications to the traffic flow, parking, turning restrictions and/or pavement markings, and are to be approved by the Commissioner of Public Works in consultation with the Director of the Planning Department and the Chief of the Newton Police Department. These changes are temporary in nature and would revert to original conditions unless Traffic Council subsequently votes to make these temporary conditions permanent. At any time, the Police Department may end any Traffic Council trial.

- TC165-COUNCILORS LEARY AND GREENBERG, requesting to add EV Charging Stations and/or EV Shared Vehicles into the Adams Street Parking Lot.
- TC166-20 COUNCILORS LEARY AND GREENBERG, requesting to add EV Charging Stations and/or EV Shared Vehicles into the Pearl Street Parking Lot.

During 2020, Traffic Council approved 92% of all items discussed and took no action on 7% of items discussed. No docketed item was denied in 2020. Two items were appealed to City Council in 2020. They include the following:

- TC87-19 ISAAC PRIZANT, TRAFFIC ENGINEER, requesting to discuss and potentially to remove some or all of the stop signs in the City's Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR), and in the field, at the intersection of Roosevelt Road at Theodore Road.
 <u>ACTION: APPROVE 5-0.</u> Traffic Council voted to removes the stop signs on Roosevelt Road, in both directions, and to retaining the stop signs on Theodore Road, in both directions. CITY COUNCIL SUBSEQUENTLY VOTED TO UPHOLD THE VOTE OF THE TRAFFIC COUNCIL.
- TC156-20 COUNCILORS LEARY, GREENBERG and DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR, on behalf of Nicholas O'Connor of 154 Washington Street and Meagan McGinnes of 241 Tremont Street, Newton Corner, requesting to expand the Newton Corner Parking District to include Tremont Street, Whittemore Road, Hibbard Road, the section of Waverley Avenue between Tremont Street and Washington Street, and the section of Washington Street between St. James Street and the Boston City Line. If approved, this item would change the parking regulations in these areas and would allow residents to purchase a resident permit, which would permit them to park their vehicles for a longer period than the posted time limit allows. ACTION: APPROVE AS AMENDED 5-0. Traffic Council voted to extend the Newton Corner Parking District to the following locations, with a 2-hour limit 8am-6pm except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, except by Newton Corner permit: Grasmere Street, Tremont Street, the section of Washington Street between Hibbard Road and the Boston City Line, the section of Waverley Avenue between Tremont Street and Washington Street, and Whittemore Road. Hibbard Road and the section of Washington Street between St. James Street and Hibbard Road are not included in the Parking District and the current parking regulations in these areas are not changed. This item restricts parking on the southern side of Whittemore Road due to the narrow width of the street, for safety purposes. THIS ITEM HAS NOT YET BEEN DISCUSSED BY THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE OR THE CITY COUNCIL.
