 - **Update:** Accommodations for patients with vision loss (language-"go there", touching - pulling patients, etc.) at hospital entrance COVID check in and any tests, procedures, etc. and navigating way around the hospital.

 - Public accessible restrooms missing toilet grab bars
 - Mask wearing requirement in hospital and in White Building/physician offices
