### TREE MITIGATION PLAN

## 41 Washington Street Subdivision and New Residence

## Existing Trees on the Project Site subject to Ordinance:

As shown on the attached plan: these are the following trees on site that will be protected during the development of the new house:

Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 28" DBH – very poor condition\* 9" DBH #6 Sugar Maple, Acer saccharinum #7 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 10" DBH #8 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 12" DBH #9 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 18" DBH #10 Unknown 10" DBH #11 Yellowwood, Cladrastis kentukea 8"+6" DBH **#12** Norway Spruce Picea abies 13" DBH #13 Norway Spruce Picea abies 13" DBH #14 Norway Spruce Picea abies 18" DBH **#15** Norway Spruce Picea abies 24" DBH #16 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 36" DBH #17 Sugar Maple, Acer saccharinum 20" DBH #18 Sugar Maple, Acer saccharinum 20" DBH #19 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 36" DBH

#2 Red Oak Quercus rubra 14.5" DBH
#3 Sugar Maple, Acer saccharinum 9" DBH
#4 Black Cherry, Prunus serotine 11" DBH
#5 Yellowwood, Cladrastis kentukea 8" DBH
#20 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 32" DBH
#21 Yellowwood, Cladrastis kentukea 8" DBH
#22 Black Walnut, Juglans nigra 22" DBH
#23 Yellowwood, Cladrastis kentukea 8" DBH
#24 Norway Maple, Acer platinoides 25" DBH

# Total 137.5 caliper inches (Not including trees noted with \*) This tree is a hazard and should be removed. It is not counted in the replacement trees

## **Proposed Replacement Trees**

The Planting Plan shows the following trees planted on site in compensation for the DBH trees removed:

- 6 Amelanchier cal. 8-10' ht. 5" = 30" cal. inches
- 2 Alaskan Cedar 8-10' 4" cal. = 8" cal. Inches
- 3 Sweet Gum 3"-3.5" cal. = 10.5" cal. Inches
- 3 Green Giant Cedar 8-10' 4" cal. = 12" cal. Inches
- 16 Emerald Green Arborvitea 8'-10' 4" cal. = 64" cal. Inches

Total 124.5" cal. inches

### **Tree Protection**

The contractor shall flag the trees proposed to be removed for approval by the Landscape Architect prior to removal. As directed by the Landscape Architect, the Contractor shall install a 6' chain link fence to limit the operations of excavation equipment and construction equipment; and construction activities and storage as shown on the Tree Protection Plan.
