- AP1-21 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, on behalf of local residents requesting to remove the following accessible parking space as it is no longer needed: Chapel Street: In front of 180 Chapel Street. (Ward 1) [03/18/21 @ 9:07 AM]
