City of Newton, Planning Department (Virtual & Onsite Components)



Interns with the Planning & Development Department will support community engagement and outreach as well as collection of qualitative data to learn more about how Newton community members experience their village centers as well as what they envision for them, to inform future zoning proposals – this may include on-the-spot surveying and storefront mapping.

West Suburban YMCA

The West Suburban YMCA, a charitable non-profit organization, strengthens the foundations of our community by supporting youth development, healthy living and social responsibility for all. Interns at the WSYMCA work in a variety of departments: aquatics, membership, creative arts, and more.



Sandwich Works

Are you interested in learning more about a career in the food industry? Sandwich Works located in Newton Centre, serves breakfast, lunch and dinner six days a week in conjunction with catering parties and special events. Interns will learn and be exposed to the many aspects of this industry from food prep, stocking and cleaning, light cooking and customer service.



New Art Center

The New Art Center is a non-profit community art education space which offers everyone, at all levels of ability, exceptional opportunities to make, exhibit, view, think about and talk about art. The student intern would work with our Studio Coordinator to support the needs of this community art education space. Daily responsibilities include helping keep our supplies stocked and organized for our summer youth programs, setting up studio classroom spaces, and assisting with some exhibition installation.

Newton Free Library

Located on Homer Street in Newton, the Newton Free Library brings the community together to enjoy, explore, create, and discover. Interns will support elementary age programs, as well as support the day-to-day tasks of a librarian and learn the operations of a library.



Newton Housing Authority

The housing authority provides high standard affordable housing to its diverse population of more than 1300 residents and is the largest affordable housing provider in the City of Newton. Beyond housing, the Housing Authority provides educational opportunities and activities for its youth, adult and senior residents. Interns will engage in day to day office tasks such as filing, copying, data management and entry and office organization, as well as support and assist recreation activities.



City of Newton, Grab & Go Program



The Grab & Go program was created in response to food insecurity in the Newton community during the COVID-19 pandemic. All residents are eligible to pick-up bagged meals at Newton North or Newton South High Schools on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays from 10am-12pm. The Health & Human Services Department is looking for a motivated intern this summer to assist with distribution at one of the Grab & Go sites, and to work on data

collection/analysis and promotion for the program. Interns will also have an opportunity to learn about other social services and resources available to Newton residents and assist with projects in the Social Services Department as needed.

Historic Newton (*Virtual & Onsite Components*)

Historic Newton operates two museums: the Jackson Homestead and the Durant-Kenrick House & Grounds, as well as Newton's historic burying grounds. These programs and activities inspire engagement by bringing together community stories with connection to American history. Interns will work remotely, with minimum onsite experience. special projects, this is the internship for you!

Green Newton/City of Newton, Sustainability & Climate



The mission of Green Newton is to create an environment that is better balanced with the natural world by making significant, measurable improvements to the way we use resources. Interns will be asked to staff tables at community events to inform residents

about the City's *Take Action Steps* for reducing Newton's greenhouse gas emissions, as well as create chalk art messages in Newton's public spaces.

The elementary age summer literacy programs at Horace Mann and the Summer Success Math program at Day are looking for interns to provide academic and social support to the students enrolled, as well as provide support to staff with set up, breakdown and cleanup of day-to-day programs and activities.
