The position will work closely with the Newton Cultural Development staff team and will be introduced to all aspects of the arts and culture management.

Responsibilities:

- Revise and update cultural assets in CREATENewton maps (specifically venues and performance spaces).
- Promote events on social media
- Assist with planning, set-up, and/or management of special events (i.e. Summer Concerts)
- Conduct clerical and administrative duties such as data entry, filing, copying, etc.
- Administer submissions on Newton Arts Calendar
- Prepare and organize art kits for summer *Time for Partners* program
- Other duties as assigned.

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Be self-motivated, task oriented and able to take initiative
