 - 3/17: Officer responded to a road rage incident where two drivers got into an argument and one claimed that the other used the N word.
 - 3/29: Someone affixed a sticker from the Patriot Front, a white supremacy group, onto a city sign. Sticker removed.
 - 3/31: Two stickers on a street sign that said "Harriet Tubman, underground posse." Unclear what this represents.
 - 3/31: Two Zoom bombing incidents at NSHS (reports made to youth officer on 4/6).
 Zoom class interrupted by racial slurs and other offensive remarks. Person has been identified and officers are responding. Second incident at a PTSO event where someone used racial slurs and posted sexually suggestive videos and Swastikas. This incident is under investigation.

 - Two complaints received related to housing. Referred to community policing and MCAD.
 - Discussion on updating the complaint form based on DA's initiative to standardize complaint forms across the state and to have the form translated into languages other than English.

 - Vigil recently held at NSHS for the shootings in Atlanta and anti-AAPI hate
 - Upcoming sophomore class discussion on the shootings in Atlanta, anti-AAPI hate, and the intersectionality of race, class, and gender
