

## Mayor Ruthanne Fuller and the City of Newton present the Newton Energy Coach



For the first time, the City has hired an individual responsible for helping residents to reduce the use of fossil fuels and take advantage of MassSave and other state and utility efficiency and renewable energy programs.

The position is called Energy Coach and was an important recommendation of the City CAP (Climate Action Plan). The position will focus on four programs: home insulation, converting to high efficiency heat pumps from fossil fuel heating, cooling, and water equipment, solar electricity, and electric vehicles. Residential energy use and personal vehicles account for 59% of carbon emissions in Newton according to the CAP.
