

Mayor Ruthanne Fuller and the City of Newton present Traffic Calming Measures

Investing Now for Newton's Future

The City continues to implement traffic calming measures to reduce vehicular travel speeds, improve safety, and provide better access for all users especially in residential neighborhoods. In the upcoming year we expect to construct a number of traffic calming solutions including a raised intersection at Beethoven Avenue and Puritan Road, curb bump outs and crosswalks at the corners of Allen Avenue @ Plainfield Street and Allen Avenue @ Pine Ridge Road. We will be adding bullet islands on Waltham Street at Derby Street and Fairway Drive and reconstructing the intersection of Crafts Street and Walnut Street to narrow the roadway and add a new crosswalk. The intersection of Austin Street and Lowell Avenue is currently in design for traffic calming improvements and will be constructed as soon as the design is complete.
