## Sec. 9-7. Election of Neighborhood Area Councils; Vacancies.

(a) A neighborhood area council shall consist of 5 to 9 members. The term of office of each member shall be 2 years and until a successor is qualified.

(b) The neighborhood area council members shall be elected at large by and from voters residing in the neighborhood service area at the time of the election. The city council shall determine the time and manner of holding the elections.

The polling location in each Neighborhood Area Council area with the highest expected turnout will have poll workers assigned to administer the Area Council Election and a ballot box for ballots to be collected. In all other precincts the Warden will have Area Council ballots available when asked and will collect the voted ballots for return to City Hall at the end of the night.
