**RE:** Hydrant Inspection and Flushing Information

Beginning August 16, 2021 and continuing through October 2021 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:30 PM Monday through Friday, Department of Public Works and Fire Department personnel will be conducting fire hydrant inspection, testing, and flushing throughout the city weather permitting. During this activity residents may experience discoloration in their drinking water. This is due to iron deposits in the water main becoming dislodged during the flushing of the hydrants. This discoloration <u>DOES NOT</u> cause a health risk; however residents are encouraged to run your cold water fixture through the lowest fixture in your home until the discolored water becomes clear. Also <u>DO NOT</u> wash laundry during this period of discolored water. Visit <u>www.newtonma.gov</u> for a list of the day/s fire hydrant inspection/flushing will be performed in your area. However due to emergency calls and weather conditions, we can only specify the area that will be flushed and not the street on any given day.
