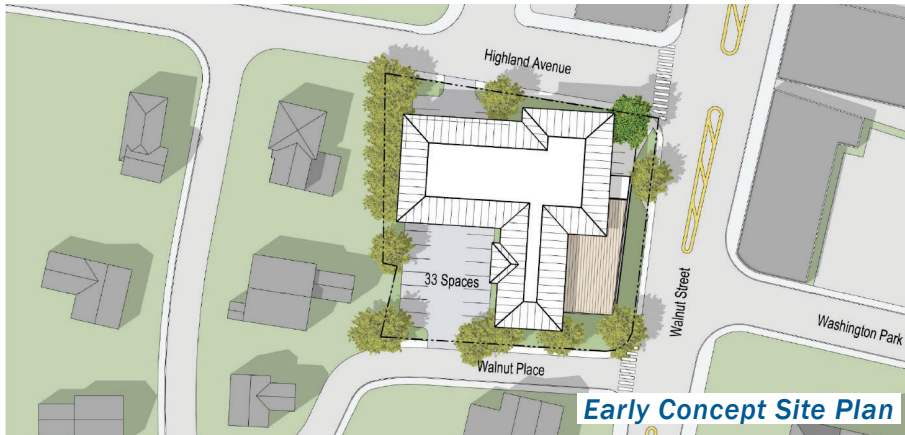

NewCAL PROJECT UPDATE

The project team and Working Group have completed the Feasibility phase of the project. Based on the overwhelming feedback in support of the proposed new construction option, and in light of the substantial shortcomings of the renovation/addition option, the Working Group formally recommended the existing Senior Center located at 345 Walnut Street in Newtonville be demolished and that a new facility be constructed in its place. On July 14 the City Council Public Facilities and Programs and Services committees voted unanimously in a straw vote to move forward with a new building.

Among the various recommendations made by the Working Group is that the design of the new facility is to fit contextually within the Newtonville Village. As the NewCAL project moves forward with the next phase of Schematic Design for new construction, regular Community meetings are resuming.
