- \*Curb Cuts in front/near White Building
- •Update: Availability of Accessible Medical Equipment, such as adjustable exam table & Slide Board for Transfer from Wheelchair, accessible Mammogram Machine
- •Update: Accommodations for patients with hearing loss undergoing testing (X-rays, MRI's, CT scans, etc.) and navigating way around the hospital

- •Update: Accommodations for patients with vision loss (language-"go there", touching pulling patients, etc.) at hospital entrance COVID check in and any tests, procedures, etc. and navigating way around the hospital.
  - Way Finding/Signs
  - Update: Emergency Room regarding people with disabilities including PCAs (or family member or guardian, etc.), ventilators, mental health issues, etc.
  - Update: Smoking on sidewalk in front of hospital
  - Restrooms missing grab bars at toilet in Green Building
