#116-19(2) Extension of time to act on a wireless attachment grant of location

EXTENET SYSTEMS, INC. agrees to an EXTENSION OF TIME in which to ACT until JUNE 18, 2019 on Petition #116-19 to install a small cell wireless facility on an existing city-owned streetlight pole located in the right-of-way in the vicinity of 140 Commonwealth Avenue. The installation will include an antenna, radio equipment, an electric meter, and cabling for fiber and power to enhance wireless coverage in the area.

#115-19(2) Extension of time to act on a wireless attachment grant of location
