

Appliances, Electronics, Metal Items, Mattresses, Box Springs

Optional curbside collection: appliances, large electronics, large metal items cost \$25 per item; mattresses/box springs cost \$60 per item.

Drop off at the Resource Recovery Center:

TVs/monitors: \$25 per item; mattresses/box springs: \$35 per item.

For items with a fee, requests may be submitted online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay or at Customer Service in Newton City Hall to pay by cash, check or credit card.



Proof of fee payment must be presented to the site attendant at drop-off. Pay online or at City Hall.

Payments for pickup requests received by 10am on Friday will be picked up the following week on *Thursday* (or *Friday* if it is a holiday week).

Bulky Item Pickup

Curbside collection: oversized items cost \$20 fee per item. See payment instructions above. Payments for bulky waste pickup requests received by 10am on Friday will be picked up the following week *on your trash day*.

- Couches
- Tables
- Chairs
- Wood furniture
- All other non-recyclable large items
- Carpeting (bundled/rolled, 4ft or less, less than 50lbs)
- Wood (bundled, less than 4ft long, less than 50lb)
