- TC75-21 <u>DAVID KENNEY</u>, 22 Agawam road, requesting the one -hour parking from 8:00am to 5:00pm., entire length, both sides, be changed to one -hour limit, 8:00am to 5:00pm., except by resident parking permit, entire length, both sides. (Ward 5) [10/06/21 @ 3:31 PM]
- ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 783. This item may be appealed through the close of business January 5, 2022.
- TC84-21 COUNCILORS [CROSSLEY,] DOWNS, AND HUMPHREY requesting a Safety Zone on Allen Avenue. (Ward 5) [11/23/2021 @ 3:15 PM] [Revised 11/30/2021 @ 9:07 AM]
- ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 784. This item may be appealed through the close of business January 5, 2022.

- TC79-21 <u>ISAAC PRIZANT, CITY TRANSPORTATION ENGINEER</u>, requesting to trial a parking restriction on the east side of Centre Street, beginning at Allerton Road heading 50 feet southerly, to improve sight lines exiting Allerton Road westbound. (Ward 6) [10/18/2021 @ 10:34 AM]

- DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR, requesting to add the following metered zone into the TPR, to correct an omission: Union Street between Langley and Beacon, south side. Note that eight parking meters have been installed along this section of Union Street, and this item will make no change in the field, with exception of the metered parking space positioned at the merge of Union Street at Beacon Street, which may be removed as a safety improvement. This item will also officially restrict parking on the north side of this section of Union Street, also representing no change in the field. (Ward 6) [11/23/2021 @ 3:15 PM]
