Building Trades Exploration

YouthBuild Boston's 6-9 month Building Trades Exploration program is geared towards students who need their high school equivalency diploma and are interested in participating in community building and vocational training opportunities. This program is being offered in a hybrid format for the safety of our students and staff.

Young people between the ages of 17 and 24 will receive:

- A bi-weekly stipend
- OSHA 10, First Aid/Adult CPR, and NCCER Certifications
- Virtual and in-person HiSET preparation classes
- Instruction in rough carpentry, and introduction to painting, landscaping, and facilities maintenance
- Access to the AmeriCorps program by becoming a member and earning a \$1,600 Segal Education Award
- Weekly service learning opportunities
- Job readiness, shadowing and internship opportunities

Successful graduates can pursue college opportunities, advanced training, or entry-level jobs in a variety of fields. College partners include Benjamin Franklin and Wentworth Institute of Technology.

YouthBuild Boston's Building Trades Exploration Program is an Equal Opportunity Employer/Service Provider with grant funding provided by the U.S. Department of Labor Employment & Training Administration (USDOL/ETA) in the amount of \$813,600.00 (YB-34323-19-60-A-25). 80% of BTE program funding comes from the USDOL/ETA, 20% is funded by nongovernmental sources.
