Review for Temporary Certificate of Occupancy

In accordance with Council Order #318-20, dated October 19, 2020, the following has been submitted to the Planning Department by the petitioner:

- statement by a registered architect or engineer certifying compliance with Condition #1 (Condition 4(a))
- final as-built plans in paper and digital format signed and stamped by a licensed land surveyor (Condition 4(c))

The Planning Department notes that Condition 4(b) requires that before a Final Certificate of Occupancy can be issued the petitioner must submit a statement by the City Engineer certifying that improvements authorized by the Order have been constructed to the standards of the Engineering Division. That office has indicated that it approves the issuance of a Temporary CO at this time, with the Final CO pending completion of certain weather dependent sidewalk and street repairs.

Given the foregoing, the Planning Department has no objection to the issuance of a temporary certificate of occupancy at this time.
