


Zoning District: SR2 **Old Lot Status-Plan of 1945

**Lot 431 is old lot status, however, as shown on proposed permit plan entitled, "Proposed Grading and Building Location", dated March 25, 2004, last revised April 19, 2004, the existing house was constructed utilizing the allowed FAR Bonus of 0.05. Therefore, the existing lot is subject to New Lot side and rear setbacks. An average of the required front setbacks of the abutting parcels were used to establish a front setback requirement of the existing lot of 25.0'.

Note: Existing zoning district information and lot status is based on information obtained from the City of Newton on-line data base and property deeds and plans obtained from Middlesex South District Registry of Deeds. Final zoning district, lot status and setback requirements to be determined by the City of Newton Inspectional Services Department.
