Rules and Regulations for Resident Parking

- 1. Motor vehicle must be registered in the Commonwealth and have a gross weight of less than 2 1/2 tons.
- 2. Vehicle must be principally garaged in the City of Newton.
- 3. Vehicle must be owned or used by a resident of the City of Newton.
- 4. Applicants must show proof of residency (current registration).
- 5. Residents of single, two family, apartment building, multi-family or condominium may received two (2) parking stickers per dwelling.
- 6. Where there exists a home office or home occupation in a dwelling unit, the maximum number of visitor's placard may be increased by one (1), unless the home office is that of a physician or dentist, stickers can be increased by two (2).
- 7. Resident Parking stickers shall be permanently affixed to the windshield on the lower left corner of the motor vehicle.
- 8. The fee for Resident Parking stickers will be \$25.00 per vehicle. The fee for replacement stickers will be \$2.00
- 9. Two (2) Visitor Parking placards may be issued per dwelling unit and are transferable between vehicles. Placards assigned may be used only for <u>visitors to the issued dwelling</u>. <u>Lost placards will not be replaced</u>.
- 10. For a home office of home occupation, Visitor Placards increase by one (1).
- 11. Visitor and Temporary Placards will be place on driver's side of front windshield, and must be completely readable.
- 12. *Resident stickers <u>do not allow</u> overnight parking between November 15 and April 15.
- 13. *Parking restrictions do not apply on legal holidays, Sundays from 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM, on Saturdays or at religious services at a house of worship or during municipal, public or community school events
- 14. *All stickers and placards must be affixed to the lower left corner of the drivers side windshield.
- 15. *All stickers and placards will be void during snow emergency.
- 16. *All parking fines for the vehicle must be paid before issuance.
- 17. *All stickers and placards will expire on December 31, of each year.
- 18. *All stickers and placards are only effective on the street assigned.
