BY THE CITY OF NEWTON  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION  
UNDER G.L. C. 92, § 79

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission (“Commission”) of the City of Newton, a Massachusetts municipal corporation having an address of 1000 Commonwealth Avenue, Newton, Massachusetts 02459 (“City”), acts as the board of park commissioners for the City for all intents and purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, acting by and through its Department of Conservation and Recreation, 251 Causeway Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02114 (“Department”), intends to acquire under its power of eminent domain perpetual and non-exclusive easements over certain parcels of Riverside Road in Newton, believed to be a City public way, for the purposes of open space, recreation and the purposes set forth by G.L. c. 92, § 33, including but not limited to the right for perpetual public access for such purposes and the right, but the obligation, to construct and maintain a bicycle and pedestrian path and bridge.

The Commission, at a duly noticed and held meeting of the Commission held on \_\_\_\_\_, 2022, upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Commission:

VOTED: To concur with and otherwise approve the taking by the Department, acting by and through its Commissioner, under the power of eminent domain pursuant to G.L. c. 92, § 79 to acquire such easements for such purposes over the parcels of land located at Riverside Road in Newton, Massachusetts, including the land under the Charles River for the construction and maintenance of a recreational path and bridge.
