The Councilor also felt that the Commission on Elder Services and the Mass Commission on Discrimination should be provided the opportunity to weigh in as it was felt that older workers could face layoffs because they would be unable to rake or sweep. The Chair of the Programs & Services Committee noted that the item had been discussed for over two years and he was opposed to sending it back to Committee.
