Booth assignments will be distributed at the NAC tent (located in front of the Senior Center) at 10:30 a.m. on the day of the event. Booth set-up begins at 10:30 am and should be completed by 11:30 a.m. The section of Walnut Street between Newtonville Avenue and Cabot Street will be closed to traffic and parking. On the day of the event, please enter on Highland Avenue (via Lowell Avenue) to unload. Then you will need to move your vehicle; parking for the event is at Newton North High School.
