




Availability of Spaces for TIGER Permit-Holders, When Adding In the Austin Lot

The ongoing Traffic Council
Trial allows vehicles
displaying TIGER permits to
park in any legal space in the
Austin Street Lot during
school days, without paying
the meter.

Overall average occupancy in the Austin Street Lot observed to be: 34% (41/119 spaces occupied).

Best estimate: on average, 17 HS students park in the Austin St Lot (TIGER + non-TIGER) on School Days, representing the difference between parked cars on an MCAS day vs. a regular school day.

16 of the 150 permits issued are to students who live within 1 mile of the school. Distance is not a factor in the Lottery System. Note that distance does not consider:

- Ability of student to walk to and from school
- After-school and before-school activities and responsibilities
- Students who live in more than one household

Discussion Topics

- Should City Council change the Student TIGER Permit fee?
 - Note: increasing the TIGER Permit Fee may increase the frequency of use and reduce the number of spaces available within the reserved TIGER zones.
 (Maybe more parking in the neighborhood & in the Austin St Lot)
 - Note: remember that some free, all-day, convenient parking is available on Brandeis Rd for NSHS students
- Should any additional TIGER permits be issued?
- Should parking continue to be allowed in the Austin Street Lot?
- Should the current Pick-Up / Drop-Off zone on Lowell Avenue revert back to TIGER permit parking?
