BULKY ITEM PICK UP

Curbside collection of oversized items is available for a \$20 fee per item. Requests may be submitted online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay. Payments for bulky waste pickup requests received by 10am on Friday will be picked up the following week on your trash day.

- Couches
- Mattresses
- Chairs
- Carpeting (bundled/rolled, 4ft or less, less than 50lbs)
- Wood (bundled, less than 4ft long, less than 50lb)

APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS & METAL ITEMS

Optional curbside collection of large appliances, electronics and scrap metal items is available for a \$25 fee per item. Requests may be submitted online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay. Except TVs/monitors, these items are accepted for drop-off at no cost at the Resource Recovery Center at 115 Rumford Avenue.

TVs/monitors have a \$25 per item fee for pickup or drop-off. Proof of payment must be presented to the attendant at drop-off. Pay online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay.
