

Lt. Arthur O. Jones Memorial

Approved on April 13, 1978, an act designated the bridge over the Massachusetts Turnpike at Washington and Putnam Streets the Lt. Arthur O. Jones Bridge in memory of a Newton serviceman who fought in the Korean War as an artilleryman and was killed in action in 1952. Similar commemorations can be found throughout the United States as a public reminder of our fallen heroes. The plaque reads:
