

Below is a summary of the work to be done at the Carr Elementary School:

The City of Newton plans to renovate multiple elementary schools in the coming years. To facilitate these plans, the City will use swing space where elementary schools of various sizes can be moved during the approximately two year construction period for each school. The Carr Elementary School building has been selected to serve this purpose and the City intends to renovate and add new square footage as necessary to the existing Carr School building. The original Carr School was constructed in 1934 and an addition was completed in 1966. It was decommissioned as a public elementary school more than 30 years ago but has served as swing space, and supported a day care, a music school and other private functions in the intervening years.

The total existing square footage is approximately 45,000 GSF and there will be some small additions made of approximately 2000 GSF for an elevator and two additional classrooms. The design firm of Turowski 2 Architecture, Inc. (Architect) has been retained and the building is intended to be the equivalent of LEED silver certified however certification itself is not being sought.

The scope of the work includes renovations throughout the entire building including but not limited to demolishing and replacing flooring, ceilings, hardware, windows, doors, roofs, all mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and information technologies systems, a stage, some staircases and a greenhouse. There will be some relocation of interior walls and structural floors, as well as an addition for an elevator and two classrooms over an existing boiler room where the roof will be lowered to create the new space at the first floor level. New energy efficient systems and assemblies will be installed. There will be repair of exterior walls including repair to masonry, granite, wood, and other materials. There will be site work including revising parking areas, sidewalks, curb cuts and crossings, demolishing sheds, stairs and other miscellaneous site structures, and creating new parking, recreation areas, driveways, maintenance and loading areas and landscaping.
