The review was continued from a previous working session. Phillip and Nicki Dawes and Diane Lim presented an application to renovate the existing house including replacing roofing, siding, windows, doors, gutters, downspouts; changing the front elevation roof line; adding dormers and an entry portico; changing the window and door program; building a second-story addition on the garage; adding garage lights; and building new walkways. Trim and casing details were provided per the request of the Commission architect. The proposed casings were very simple. The new brick paver walkways would be four feet wide.

### <u>51 Page Road – Certificate of Appropriateness</u>

Jen and Joel Shectman presented a project to build a vestibule and entry at the back; add two basement egress windows and window wells and build a side exit door, landing and stairs with railings on the right side. The windows were made by American Craftsman and the stairs, landings and railings would be stained cedar. Window casings and trim would be Azek and match existing. The window wells would be flush with the ground and have a safety cap or grate that was also flush with the ground.
