


WHY ANOTHER PLAY STRUCTURE FOR WELLINGTON?

- Current facilities are ideal for toddlers/young children
- Kids 5-12+ outgrow the tot lot and need more play options
- COVID has increased park use
- Location is underutilized space in the park
- Nothing like the proposed structure in the surrounding area
 - Fully ADA accessible and inclusive
 - Sensory-focused play
 - Fosters social/emotional development
- Community members support a larger, accessible structure



PROCESS

- Invited community to participate in Friends of Wellington Park, Inc. (FWP); formed core working group
- Introduced to Stephanie Lapham, Recreation Manager
- Playground Sub-Committee met with Stephanie to measure the space and discuss project requirements
- Contacted pre-approved vendors requesting designs
- Narrowed vendors down to top 3 through a FWP vote
- Interviewed top 3 vendors with Stephanie and FWP groupAsked standard list of questions
- FWP voted and selected Kompan as vendor
- FWP voted on top structure design
- FWP presented to PRC on 9/20/2021



COST BREAKDOWN

Excavation: \$4,600

Equipment: \$62,221.11

Installation:\$34,749.70

Surfacing: \$18,690.00

Subtotal: \$120,260.81

20% Contingency: \$18,294

Total: \$138,554.81

Use of \$50,000 Korff Funds Earmarked for Wellington Park:

Existing Playground Surfacing: \$35,921 Amount Leftover for New Structure: \$14,079

Amount to Fundraise: \$124,475.81

Notes:

- Equipment cost is discounted by 35%
- Fully installed by Kompan (no longer a community build)
- Surfacing type will be wood chips with ADA accessible rubber matting
