Dear Parent:

Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship with Newton Parks, Recreation & Culture. Please complete the scholarship application and return that with a copy of your 2022 Federal Income Tax Return, AFDC Card, or other documents to prove income eligibility.

In order to be eligible for a scholarship from Newton Parks, Recreation & Culture:

1. you must be a Newton Resident
2. your income must fall within the low to moderate income guidelines as outlined on the Community Development Block Grant Service Eligibility Income Limits (pg 2)
3. children must be enrolled in one of our camps

Applications are due no later than **May 1, 2023** and scholarships will be awarded by May 15, 2023. Applications received after May 1 will be considered if additional scholarship funds remain.

In 2022 we were able to award \$30,000.00 in scholarship funds to families in need. While we aren't able to fully fund a child's camp experience, we make a concerted effort to award amounts that help reduce the out of pocket expenses that families have to pay to ensure children can attend at least a few weeks of camp each summer. In addition to scholarships, we are able to set up a payment plan for families to pay their remaining balance. All balances must be paid before your child attends camp.

Below is a sample of estimated award amounts from previous years. Award amounts vary each year based on the number of applicants and the amount of money in our scholarship fund (which is supplemented through grants and donations).

Community Development Block Grant Service Eligibility Income Limits

Projects funded by the City of Newton CDBG Program can assist people in Newton whose household income is within the following limits, effective April 1, 2022.

In addition, *adults with disabilities, survivors of domestic violence, homeless people, abused children, people with AIDS, people who are illiterate, and elders* are presumed to be eligible for services.
