This form cannot be used to register to vote, but can be used to change Political Party/Designation and update address if moved within the City of Newton. A voter's signature is required to process changes. See reverse side for full instructions.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### **CURRENT RESIDENTS:**

1. Verify ALL information listed on this form.
2. OCCUPATION: Enter occupation, not the place of employment.
3. MOVED or DECEASED – Enter “M” for **MOVED** or “D” for **DECEASED** if appropriate.
4. NATIONALITY: Enter “Nationality” only if not a U.S. citizen.
5. VETERAN: Enter “Y” if a U.S. Veteran.

### **ADDING FAMILY MEMBERS:**

1. List ALL current family/household members who reside at the legal address being listed on this form.
  - a. Including any family member(s) who are in military service, at a rest home, or nursing facility.
2. Complete all applicable column information INCLUDING “Date of Birth”.

### **PARTY AND VOTING ADDRESS CHANGES (for already registered NEWTON voters):**

2. For residents who no longer reside at the listed address, place a line through the name.
  - a. If that resident is a voter, their original signature is required to remove them from the voter rolls.
